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## PROGRAM ACTIVITIES EXPLAINED

1. **Projects Presentation** - Each delegation will present the project developed in their own country to a group of 6 to 7 other delegations. There will be 5 to 6 rooms for simultaneous presentations.

  2. Change Actions - Beach cleaning campaign, painting a mural, banners for the march for the Oceans, Creating panels & Awareness raising sessions in kindergartens (on marine litter degradation, sustainable fish consumption, micro plastic in sediments and sand, etc.)
